

## 1. Edmond About (Dieuze, 1828 - Paris, 1885)

Edmond Lambert

Autograph dedication signed on visiting card by the French writer, journalist and art critic. About addresses the literate Edmond Lambert (1875-1940): "Être applaudi par les griffes du plus malin et du plus spirituel des chats, ce n'est pas un médiocre succès, mon cher Lambert...". (10 x 6.5 cm).



**23. Gustave Chadeuil** (Limoges 1828 - 1896)




**24. François-Adolphe Chambolle** (Chataigneraie 1802 - Parigi 1883)




**25. Félicien Champsaur** (Turriers, 1858 - Paris, 1934)

Franz Wedekind's *Lulu*

Autograph letter signed, dated "9 avril 88" by the French poet, journalist and dramatist. He left a large body of journalistic and literary work to posterity, including "Dinah Samuel", based on his affair with Sarah Bernhardt, and "Lulu", a clownish novel published in 1888, which inspired Franz Wedekind's "Pandora's Box" and Alban Berg's opera. To a colleague: "...Laissez-moi vous dire toutefois que je ne ... par M. Zola personnellement, que non seulement je ne suis pas allé à Medan avec une lettre de M. 




## 27. Ferdinand Chastanet (Paris 1858 - 1943)

Emile Zola

Lot of seven autograph letters signed, dated between 1889 and 1893, by the French theatre administrator, author of the first dictionary of the Rougon-Macquart, published in 1901 and director of Théâtre Libre (today Théâtre Antoine). Letters are addressed to Henry Lapauze and friends. Autograph letter signed dated "Nice 19 février 1860" by the politician and man of letters, lawyer at the Paris Court of Appeal, author of the 3-volume work entitled 'Réminiscences' (1862-1869) on socio-political issues. A passage by way of example. "*La seule manière de mettre fin au séculaire conflits du sacerdoce et de l'Empire, serait, non de persécuter les prêtres...*". 3 pp. in-8.




**37. Alphonse Daudet** (Nîmes, 1840 - Paris, 1897)

*Daudet and Henry James in London*

Fine letter signed "Alph. Daudet", "London" not dated (1895), by the French writer and playwright. Daudet apologizes to his correspondent for not being able to accept "... l'invitation si gracieuse que vous m'adressez pour le prochain dîner de l'Authors' Club". 1 p. In-8. The Daudet - Alphonse, his wife Julia and their children - left for London on May 6, 1895; with Henry James as cicerone, they visited London, Windsor and Oxford. Their journey ended on May 27. 


























